Strawberry Icebox Dessert

5 cups sweetened whipped cream (I use the large carton)

12-14 large rectangular graham crackers

3 1/2 cups chopped strawberries

Step 1: Spread a thin layer of prepared whipped cream in a 9x13 glass baking dish.

Step 2: Layer graham crackers on top, and then cover with whipped cream.

Step 3: Sprinkle 1/3 of the strawberries on top, and then cover with whipped cream again.

Step 4: Repeat steps 2 and 3 until no more ingredients remain. (The top layer should be strawberries and shouldn't be covered with whipped cream.)

Step 5: Refrigerate for at least 3 hours.
